McChoir's Music Corner

We heard from the Gospel of St. Luke today, but I'd like to make a short detour to the Gospel of St. John, who wrote that Jesus "came to what was his own, but his own people did not accept him." (*Jn 1:11*) Just a couple of verses later, John writes "And the Word became flesh, and made his dwelling among us..." (*Jn 1:14*) Keep that in mind now with today's Gospel passage from Luke, which recounts the beginning of Jesus' public ministry in the synagogue at Nazareth. Jesus, the Word made flesh, dwells among the people of his hometown ("his own people") and proclaims the prophetic words of Isaiah, telling those gathered that "today this scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." (*Lk 4:21*) Ipso ergo: 'I am the anointed one of God.'

Today we sang a new hymn titled, "Only Begotten, Word of God Eternal." This hymn is great for today's reading as we see Jesus reveal himself as the 'Only-Begotten Word made flesh' in his action at the synagogue. To assist us with learning this new hymn, we sang it today for Offertory, and will sing it again next week as a processional hymn, and once more the following week at communion time. The repetition of a melody like this one will be helpful as your ear processes the music to assist you in joining in song from the pew!
