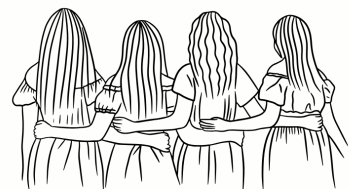

McChoir's Music Corner

Formally speaking, today is the 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time, and here at Sts. Anne & Joachim, we also recognize the anniversary of the dedication of our parish, as this Sunday is proximally the closest to February 11, when the church was dedicated in 2010. What a gift it is to be part of this church where families can gather, and be active with opportunities for people in every phase of life! The phrase "a family of families" really hits the nail on the head around here: we are all united in Christ! With that in mind, today's opening hymn is worth a moment of reflection. "Christ is Made the Sure Foundation" is also the Divine Office Hymn for the Dedication of a Church.

The Catechism states that "visible churches are not simply gathering places but signify and make visible the Church living in this place, the dwelling of God with men reconciled and united in Christ." (§1180) I think the third verse of our opening hymn speaks to this truth quite well: "To this temple of your honor, Come, O Lord of Hosts, today; In your faithful loving kindness Hear your servants' prayers and praise. And your fullest benediction Shed within its walls always." Since 2010 we've been making a joyful noise to the Lord in this Church; may we continue to sing now and always in thanksgiving for God's abundant blessings!

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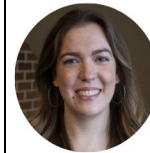
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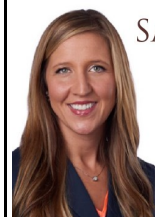


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
