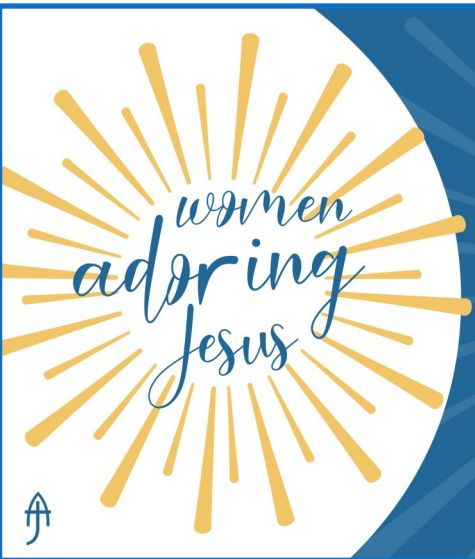

McChoir's Music Corner

Today's offertory hymn was the sweet chant melody, "Ubi Caritas," and we sang the English adaptation of this beautiful text. It is hard to pinpoint where many of these chant melodies come from specifically, as it was an oral tradition long before melodies were ever written down. This "Ubi Caritas" chant is one of the few that we have some evidence of as early as the 4th century! These kinds of hymns can really trip us up in the 21st century—we're used to a different 'feel' to our music. Time signatures and a consistent rhythm, known as 'the beat,' dominate our musical language in the modern era. Chant is timeless (in more ways than one!), and because of that, the music flows without a dictated beat like we have in our music of today.

This style of music has always been preferable to the Catholic Church, because the meditative qualities naturally present in chant lend themselves particularly well to prayer. Since we are not as used to that in our day-to-day musical inputs, it can be difficult to enter into prayer with chants like this due to unfamiliarity. And perhaps that is why it is so important that we sing chant: we don't do it anywhere else but here, in the temple of the Lord. By maintaining a musical style like chant that is so distinct from other genres and styles of music, we have something that the Catholic Church calls "sacred, or, "set apart," for worship. So, if it feels unfamiliar—press on! We've been singing more of the chant style each week from the communion chant, responsorial psalm, and gospel acclamation. The repetition we get in in the chant style will continue to become more familiar and comfortable in the coming weeks!
