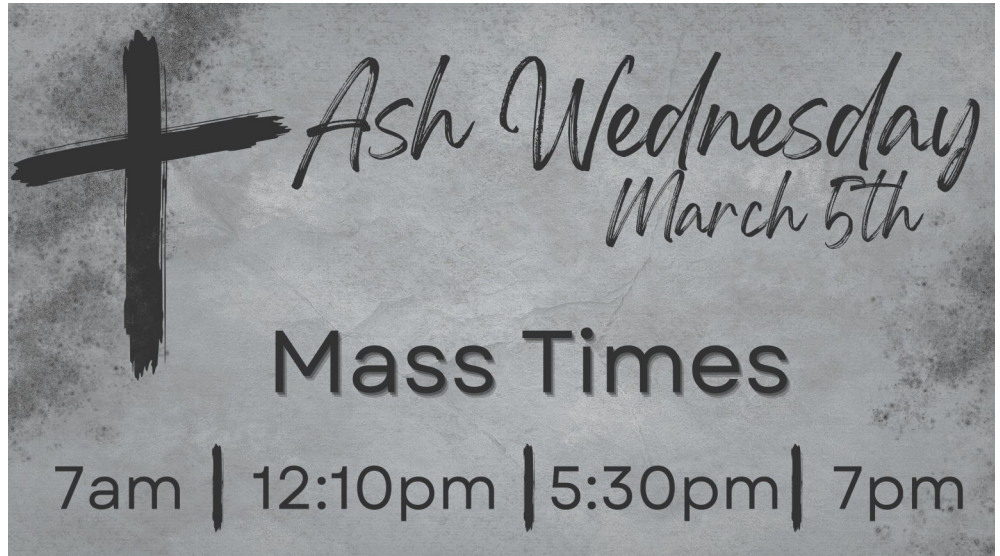

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

McChoir's Music Corner

Did you feel like we sang a lot of “Alleluia” today? Well, we did—and it was very intentional! Naturally, we had the Gospel Acclamation “Alleluia,” our Communion Hymn was “Alleluia! Sing to Jesus,” and if you were at the 9:15 Mass, the Choir sang a short motet by Henry Purcell and sang but one word: “Alleluia!” Lent is upon us, and this is the last time we will hear “Alleluia” until we hear it again at the Great Easter Vigil. As such, highlighting it today will accentuate the lack of Alleluia beginning on Ash Wednesday and the First Sunday of Lent next weekend. Why does the Alleluia go away? Well, Lent is a season of fasting and penance. We focus inward on ourselves and our shortcomings, recognizing our need for Christ to be our Savior.

During our 40 days of Lent, we remember the Israelites who wandered in the desert for 40 years, and we, like them, experience a sort of dryness and longing for God in the midst of our sins. The “Alleluia” (which comes from the Hebrew expression which means to ‘praise the Lord’) and the hymn “Glory to God” are omitted in Lent because of this spirit of anticipation and longing. The music we sing for our hymns and chants throughout Lent are likewise of a more somber character, but never completely withdrawn from the abundant hope and promise of our God who we know will come and save us. Like the Israelites: we march on, stubborn and sinful though we may be, knowing there is a promised land for us that will make us resound with jubilant praises upon our arrival.

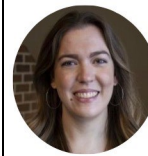
