Lenten Regulations: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

McChoir's Music Corner

"As you did hunger bear, and thirst, So teach us gracious Lord, To die to self, and chiefly live By your most holy Word." This 3rd verse of our processional hymn today is a nice generalization of the Lenten journey ahead. By 'dying to self,' we follow Jesus into the desert and experience a kind of poverty, an emptying of ourselves, so that the Lord can fill us up with what we need. We ponder our sins like the psalmist who sings: "For I know my transgressions; my sin is always before me." (*Ps 51: 5*) Psalm 51 in its entirety is a great meditation as we begin Lent. We got to hear the whole psalm proclaimed on Ash Wednesday, as one of the featured chants during the Distribution of Ashes. Pope Benedict XVI called the whole Book of Psalms the "prayer book *par excellence*, [that teaches] us how to speak to God, expressing ourselves and the whole range of our human experience with

words that God himself has given us." (*General Audience, 2011*) In the case of Psalm 51, we have a great template for making penitential prayer to the Lord: Verses 1-10 are focused on the sinful nature of man, and how our sins make us impure. Verses 11-19 are a direct plea to the Lord, our Savior, to rescue us from our sinful ways, and help us to lead others towards God, making a sacrifice of a "contrite spirit." (*Ps 51:19*) Lent is not a time to wallow in self-pity and sadness, Lent is a time to get real. Half of Psalm 51 is spent acknowledging the reality of sin. Having completed that reflection, we speak directly to Jesus and say, "Lord, you will open my lips; and my mouth will proclaim your praise." (*Ps 51: 17*) There, too, is a great model for us all; to 'let go, and let God,' and that is our Lenten mission.

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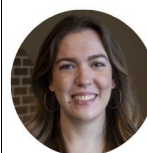
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
