For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

McChoir's Music Corner

Today's Gospel features a great line from Peter: "Master, it is good that we are here." Whenever I see this passage come up in the Gospel, I know it is time to sing "Tis Good Lord, to Be Here." This hymn-text was written in 1890 by the Anglican priest J. Armitage Robinson, who was a prolific preacher at Westminster Abbey in London. A hymn text like this one can be called a "metrical paraphrase" of scripture, where a passage is set poetically to a specific meter, so it can be sung with ease to a variety of tunes. The melody for this hymn was written over a century before Robinson penned the text, by the Swiss Johann Martin Spiess in 1745. Spiess was not a full-time musician, and was actually the Prior (think of a 'pastor' but for a monastery) of

Irsee Abbey for a time in southern Germany. I love stumbling upon these musicians who wrote music for the church in a variety of ages, many of them priests and other religious! We have such a rich musical heritage in our church, and we often don't know much of anything about these men and women who have helped us to worship with beautiful song throughout the centuries. I think it is so good to sing these hymns that have been sung for hundreds of years and help ground us in our faith as they did for so many holy people before us. Who knows, maybe someone from our church will write a hymn that people will be praying with in the year 2325!

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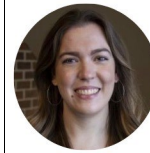
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
