Lenten Regulations: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

McChoir's Music Corner

Today, we sing "Attende Domine," or "Attend to Us, O Lord." This is a 10th-century Latin text that has been translated into English by a great modern lyricist named Kathy Pluth. I became acquainted with Kathy and asked if she might share a little insight for this column about how she goes about translating/writing a hymn. Here is what she had to say:

"Running like a river through the Christian centuries, the Latin hymns, mostly anonymous, refresh the Church by elevating our thoughts and strengthening our hearts. Few of us can read Latin anymore, and so translations are necessary. But how should they be done? My goal is to translate accurately into simple, direct texts that very clearly bring the Church's artistic hymn treasury into the present day lives of Christians."

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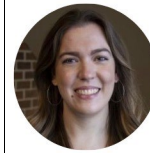
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
