Lenten Regulations: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

McChoir's Music Corner

Today's liturgy is brought to you by the word, "Hosanna!" and the number 3. Today we cry 'Hosanna' as Jesus Christ makes his triumphant arrival in Jerusalem. The opening hymn we sang has a bit of legend to its origin: The text comes from Theodulph of Orleans, a 9th-century Catholic Bishop from France. The story is that Theodulph was imprisoned for political reasons in a monastery in Angers. While he was imprisoned he wrote the hymn and sang it from the window of his cell just as Louis the Pious, King of France, was passing beneath the window in the procession on Palm Sunday in 821. The hymn so moved the king that he immediately ordered the holy bishop to be freed and restored to his see. Though there is good reason to believe this is more of a local legend than a factual account of the true story, there is one thing that is for sure: this text has

become a cornerstone for many congregations across the globe on Palm Sunday! It was translated into English by the great John M. Neale, who I've referenced a few times in these corners as a great Anglican hymn-writer who was often criticized by his colleagues for 'being too Catholic.' Sounds like a great problem to me! With Palm Sunday, we enter into Holy Week and a series of beautiful and powerful liturgies. I encourage you to check out the blog post on our website titled "Sacred Paschal Triduum: A Primer for Holy Week," there is a lot of information there to help you understand and participate more fully in these liturgies.

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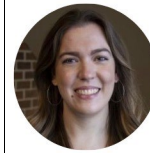
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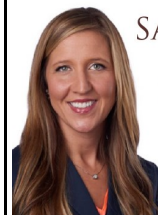
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
