McChoir's Music Corner

Today's Communion Antiphon from Luke is one of my favorite passages from scripture: "The disciples recognized the Lord Jesus in the breaking of bread, alleluia" (Lk 24: 35). Musically speaking, there's a lot to play with in there for setting text to music, and there are some lovely melodies that have been written to that end, including our chant melody from today! As for the text itself, I once read a great reflection that paired this passage with the story of Adam and Eve eating from the tree of knowledge of good and evil, "then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked." (Gen 3:7) See what happens here? When the disciples met Jesus, they did not 'see him' until Jesus broke bread with them. In the same way, Adam and Eve were not aware of their nakedness until they had eaten as well. In both cases, the act of taking food and eating it reveals something to the one who eats. In the case of Adam and Eve, the recognition of their nakedness causes them to hide and cover themselves. With the disciples, it is Jesus who was hidden, and is now revealed to those who did not recognize him. We see this happen quite often in the Gospel, where something Jesus does has an Old Testament counterpart, in some form, Jesus fulfills or perfects what came before. In this Easter season of great joy, we celebrate and proclaim the salvation of the world through Jesus Christ. He truly is our Redeemer and has conquered all that stands in our way. Bob Dylan once said, "anything worth thinking about is worth singing about." I think that is a good insight into our music as we worship as well: We ought to ponder these words we sing as well, they reveal something to us about our risen Savior.

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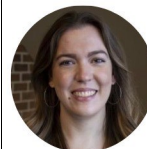
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
