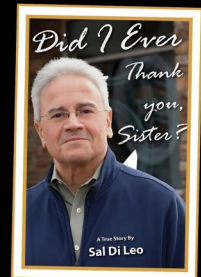

McChoir's Music Corner

The most important part of any building is its foundation. Without a solid foundation, a building will fall apart due to any number of weather events or other outside factors. The Catholic Church, too, must maintain a strong foundation, one might even say, 'a cornerstone' upon which we can rely for unfailing strength in support through all things. That foundation of course, is Jesus Christ, our Risen Lord! Today we sing a couple of hymns about Christ our foundation: "Christ is Made the Sure Foundation" (*WESTMINSTER ABBEY*) and "The Church's One Foundation" (*AURELLA*). These hymns highlight our united lives in Christ, where, with him as our foundation, we shall not be shaken, as the cantor sang with great confidence during today's responsorial psalm: "Your kingdom is a kingdom for all ages, and your dominion endures through all generations." This leads me to our offertory hymn today, "The New Jerusalem Above," (*WAREHAM*). The text comes from a hymn attributed to St. Fulbert of Chartres, a great philosopher and scholar of the 10th-11th centuries. Within this hymn, there is abundant Easter joy and praises sung to God, who "makes earth and heaven one, a kingdom of true happiness." The scriptural reference of the 'new Jerusalem' from Revelation 21 is the focal point of this great hymn, where we sing with abundant hope for the heavenly kingdom we seek to inherit at the end of our earthly pilgrimages, based upon the sure foundation the Christ has established for us by his death and resurrection. Pairing these hymns of foundation and hope for the new Jerusalem gives some substance to the phrase you may have heard before: "We are an Easter people and Alleluia is our song!" Our joyful hope established in the resurrection of Christ gives us the encouragement to sing out with Easter joy, now and forever more!

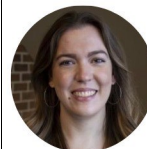
