McChoir's Music Corner

Today's feast day always has me excited for the great hymn we sang for the entrance procession: "Hail the Day that Sees Him Rise." The tune for this hymn is called LLANFAIR, and you may be surprised to learn that the composer of this hymn tune, Robert Williams, was blind! He was a basket weaver by trade, but had a gifted ear for music, and was known to have written melodies down after hearing it just once! In this case, he wrote a tune that was in a common style for Welsh composers by using the tonic triad ('do,' 'mi,' 'sol,') as the basis for the melody. This provides for a strong sense of tonality and clarity for the singer, whether an amateur in the pew or a seasoned cantor! In addition, it's written in what is called rounded bar form (AABA): the first two phrases are identical (AA), the third phrase is a counter melody to the first (B), and the final phrase is the same as the first two (A).

All of this is part of the structure behind why it is effective for encouraging congregational singing. These same structural elements are present in many nursery rhymes and other children's tunes that young ears grasp on to so well. I often prioritize these structural elements of music in my selection of hymnody, to ensure that the music we sing is always approachable by our entire congregation: young and old, trained musician or admirer—everyone can sing these hymns!

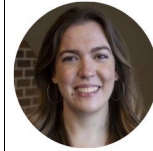
