McChoir's Music Corner

At long last, we reach the Sundays of Ordinary Time—no special feasts or solemnities today! We've had quite the stretch of celebrations since Easter ended on Pentecost about a month ago. Now that our Sundays will not have a more specific emphasis, we turn to the general mystery of Christ with the readings covering a great deal of his life on earth. Our opening hymn today sings of the holy Name of Jesus Christ: "At the name of Jesus, every knee shall bow, Every tongue confess him King of glory now; 'Tis the Father's pleasure we should call him Lord, Who from the beginning was the mighty Word." I researched the hymn-text author, Caroline Maria Noel, and found her story to be quite interesting: She was born in 1817 in Great Britain, and for over 20 years of her adult life, she endured sickness that forced her to endure great suffering.

Much of her poetry and hymnody is grounded in themes of trust and abandonment to God's providential care, where she found consolation from her constant physical pain. She used her gifts of writing to unite and uplift many others suffering in different forms: a mother who has lost her child, those who suffer loneliness without family at Christmas, the loss of a spiritual leader for a community—these relatable themes touched the hearts of many in Caroline's time, which was a boost to her own spirit as well. I hadn't considered this until I read her story, but it would seem that she embodied the words of the Apostle Paul, who we heard from in today's second reading: "From now on, let no one make troubles for me; for I bear the marks of Jesus on my body." (*Gal 6: 17*)

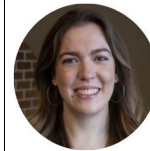
