What is Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS)? Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a Montessori-based method of religious formation for children that builds upon a child's natural sense of wonder and need to learn through rich, sensory experiences. In a traditional-style classroom, a catechist will often present to the entire group of children. In the CGS room, called the atrium, you may see the catechist gathered with children, individually or in a small group, to offer a presentation along with hands-on materials. While the catechist is presenting to a small group, the other children work individually with materials previously presented by the catechist, allowing for deeper pondering of the truths of our faith presented in the pillars of Scripture and Liturgy.

Currently, our parish offers limited sessions for Level 1 (children ages 3-6) and Level 2 (children ages 6-9). Registration for CGS will open mid-August. For more information or to schedule a tour of the Good Shepherd Atrium, please contact Sarah Bofferding, Director of Catechesis.

McChoir's Music Corner

Today's communion hymn was originally written by St. Thomas Aquinas (Adoro te devote), and the English translation we have of it was done by Gerard Manley Hopkins, a 19th century priest and poet. The last line of the first verse gives us a great 'internal posture' for our prayer: "Lost, all lost in wonder at the God thou art." Wonder is a key part of worship, but don't take my word for it! Pope Francis wrote about this in his apostolic letter, *Desiderio desideravi*: "Wonder is an essential part of the liturgical act...it is the marveling of those who experience the power of symbol..." (DD 26) What he is getting at is that the sacramental signs and symbols that are present in the liturgy should cause us to marvel at the Paschal Mystery, to foster an encounter with the living God as we worship at Mass. We do not sit in the pew saying, "I wonder what is going on up there." Rather, we sit in

the pew and say, "Lost, all lost in wonder at the God thou art." How truly wonderful is our God! As the word suggests, we are filled with wonder—awe, amazement, thankfulness—for the many gifts he has bestowed upon us, none greater than his only Son. This is what it means to wonder at the Paschal Mystery, "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." (*Jn 3: 16*) Not only do we wonder, but we 'get lost' in wonder! After communion, or after Mass has ended and we finish the final hymn, it can be good to stay in the pew for a few minutes to give thanks, to be lost in wonder at the gift we have received. By taking time to sit in awe of the gift we have received, we can foster a deeper encounter with our Lord. How wonderful!

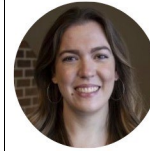
