The aim of Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is to lead the child to prayer. In the three to six-year-old child, prayer is primarily spontaneous and individual. An adult can read a Bible passage over and over again, but a child who is not yet reading is unable to independently repeat prayer in this way. The repetition that is essential for a younger child is fulfilled in the sensorial materials of the atrium. Once a child has been shown a work by the catechist, he or she can independently return to the materials whenever it is available on the shelf to ponder the truths of our faith more deeply. Perhaps the child will set up the model altar, recalling the placement and names of the items used at mass before pausing for a moment in silent prayer. Another child may choose to sit with the raised surface map of Israel, feeling the rough, high mountains and smooth waterways before placing the flags for Nazareth, Bethlehem, and Jerusalem in their places and recalling the significance of these places in the life of Jesus. Maybe a child will be drawn to the container of tiny mustard seeds, carefully placing one on his fingertip and recalling the parable of the mustard seed, contemplating what Jesus meant when he said the kingdom of God is like a mustard seed.

Each material, once it has been presented, allows for individual, independent, freely chosen, and repeated engagement with a particular truth of our faith. All of the materials of the atrium are simple, yet beautiful and child-sized. During the first CGS session of the new year, the catechist shares with the children how all of the materials have been made especially for them and how the atrium is a place for listening and speaking with God. We pray this engagement with the materials leads the child to a deepening of the relationship that already exists with God. Currently, our parish offers limited sessions Level 1 (children ages 3-6) and Level 2 (children ages 6-9).

McChoir's Music Corner

Perhaps you have heard it said before, 'Don't pray for patience or perseverance, because the Lord will just give you more opportunity to practice!' These virtues are difficult in many circumstances, and the content of our readings today gives us an opportunity for reflection. Our Lord knows through and through how difficult it is to bear a cross, and he tells us through the Apostle Paul that "In [our] struggle against sin you have no yet resisted to the point of shedding blood." Why, all of this is enough to make one feel a little sheepish! ...But I think that is okay. As a response to today's readings, I selected our Offertory hymn, "Take Up Your Cross." If you look at the text, you can see that in the midst of bearing our cross, we also sing, "His strength shall bear your spirit up...

heed not the shame...take up your cross then, in his strength..." You can plainly see that the plan isn't for us to be superheroes and endure our crosses on our own: we need God! Without God, we can't do it! If we were able to do it on our own, why would you be here reading this bulletin after Mass? We would not be at church if we didn't need Jesus Christ, our Savior, who lovingly endured his cross and laid down his life for us. So no, most of us haven't and won't 'shed blood in our resistance to sin' in the world or within our own lives. We can suffer our burdens well, and unite them to Christ, who knows what it means to suffer in a way greater than most of us can possibly imagine. What a good and gracious God we have, who loves us so deeply!

Man of the Shroud Traveling Exhibit at St. Mary's Cathedral, August 23-31, 2025: For the first time in the Diocese of Fargo, we will have an exact replica of the burial cloth of Christ, known as the Shroud of Turin, along with an exhibit of the fascinating details and history of this most precious holy cloth. The Shroud of Turin is a linen cloth that bears a faint image of the front and back of a man who died of crucifixion wounds. It has been venerated for centuries as the actual burial shroud used to wrap the body of Jesus in after his crucifixion, and upon which Jesus's bodily image is miraculously imprinted. There have been countless studies through the ages that cannot explain the image by human knowledge. The real cloth is in Turin, Italy and is currently not on display. The exhibit, Man of the Shroud, will be at St. Mary's Cathedral in the social hall for one week, August 23-31. 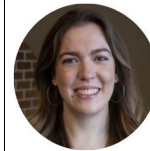
