### McChoir's *Music* Corner

**Tip #3** for singing/reading music at church: When you need to, wait. Now, I'm not giving you permission to close the book and not try at all! On the contrary, if you wait to sing yourself, the purpose should be to give yourself a chance to process the content to aid your participation. If there is something new to you that you're not comfortable singing right away, odds are that you will hear it multiple times. It could be a Mass Ordinary (Lord have mercy, Glory to God, Lamb of God, etc.) that repeats weekly, or a Responsorial Psalm/Communion Chant that repeats the congregational refrain after each verse. Perhaps it is a hymn that uses the same melody for all verses—whatever the case, you can wait and listen to gain context before adding your own voice. Suppose there is a hymn you don't know: Let the organ and cantor sing the first verse, as you follow the notes on the page in your hymnal. By looking at the notes, and hearing them sung/played, your brain will have a boost for singing when you jump in! I often notice that by singing more verses of hymns like we do, I tend to hear more people in the pews singing by the fourth or fifth verse, which is very common. Beyond the practical function of singing the notes and words on the page, I also encourage you to open up the hymnal before Mass and see what it is that we are praying with for each day. Perhaps if you look at the readings of the day before you come to Mass, you can open up the hymnal upon arrival and look at the words the whole congregation will pray in song together as well. Though it is not always a perfect thematic match between readings and music, more often than not there is a common thread that unites these things to benefit our understanding of scripture that is read at Mass. In all things, come with a spirit of prayer and openness to the Lord, he has a pretty good track record of giving us all that we need!

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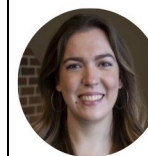
