**-pgs. 89-540: Proper of the Mass**

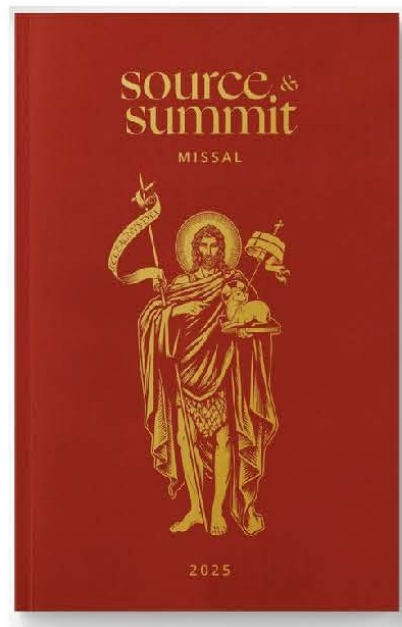
*(the antiphons and readings for each day)*

**-pgs. 835-862: Devotional Prayers**

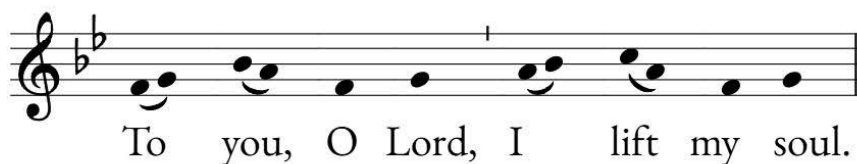
*(Prayers for before and after Mass, and beyond!)*



*Blog Post*

There is a blog post on our parish website that contains more details about the Missal itself, including examples of the music we will sing for the First Sunday of Advent to get us started. If you read the “McChoir Corner” bulletin blurbs each week, I’ve been highlighting some tips to assist with reading some of the new music you will see in this missal as well.

I think the biggest difference we will experience together is the prevalence of chant style melodies like this one: *(Responsorial Psalm For Advent I)*



For the past 3 months, our musicians have been singing the Communion Antiphon each week in this style. Perhaps you have learned a little bit by ‘osmosis’ already! It may still take some time to get the hang of it, so my encouragement to you is: jump in as you are ready! With some time and repetition, this style of singing becomes quite intuitive and satisfying to the voice. Listen intently, remembering that this is prayer for the whole church community. Even if you don’t sing with exuberant tone and full volume, everyone can pray with these snippets of scripture and other liturgical texts, allowing the words to wash over you in contemplation. We are excited to sing this style for weekly Responsorial Psalms and Communion Antiphons. Additionally, we will sing familiar hymns and return to the “Heritage Mass” Ordinary the rest of the way through Advent and Christmas to give us a little more comfort and confidence in transition.

We change out the books on Monday morning, so if you would like to thumb through it and orient yourself before Sunday, I welcome and encourage that! Our musicians are ready to support and lead you through it all, I’m sure we’ll get comfortable before too long.

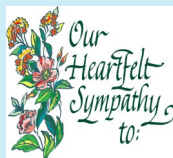

**McChoir's *Music* Corner**

Alrighty folks, many blessings to you in this season of change—today we celebrate Christ the King Sunday, the triumphant finale of the liturgical year! Next week Advent begins, and with it, we will begin singing out of the new missals. Here our last tip before the new hymnals go in the pews! **Tip #4:** Trust what you hear and go for it! A couple of weeks ago I mentioned that we tend to overthink the music reading process; sometimes you just need to listen for some general orientation, and then jump in! Use the notes on the page as a good reference for how high or low each note will be, but the context you are given by listening to the musicians will be the most helpful thing. And when I say 'go for it,' I mean take a deep breath and give your voice some good air flow to get the notes out. With intentional effort on taking a strong breath, your voice will be stronger as well, and hopefully your confidence goes with it! By imitating what you hear from the musicians who lead, you can sing just about anything we might throw your way. (We'll refrain from Bach Cantatas and the like...) What a delight it is to hear our parish in song together as we pray, it is a privilege to sing the praises of our Creator with you. Christus vincit! Christus regnat! Christus imperat! (*Christ conquers, Christ reigns, Christ rules!*)

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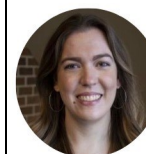
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
