**McChoir's Music Corner**

**6th Sunday of Easter**

"God is love." I could just about end the corner right there! The first words we sang today ring true throughout today's liturgy. Today's communion antiphon from John's gospel says "If you love me, keep my commandments, says the Lord, and I will ask the Father and he will send you another Paraclete, to abide with you forever, alleluia." God loves us, and that love impels us to love in return. Today's gospel tells us that "no one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." This dramatic statement is not for hyperbole or poetic interpretation, but gives witness to real, true, and abiding love. So we sing "Christians Let us Love One Another" today at communion time, as we partake in the sacrificial offering of Christ himself. The refrain sung at the end of each verse is "Everyone who loves is born of God. Jesus is our life. God is love." You probably recognize that tune known as "Let All Mortal Flesh Keep Silence" (*PICARDY*). This is a great fit to sing at today's liturgy as we recognize that the love of God asks us to love others in return, and that is a beautiful meditation to pray with after you receive Jesus in the Eucharist. Stay with that thought awhile today, and see what you can do to 'love one another' this week.

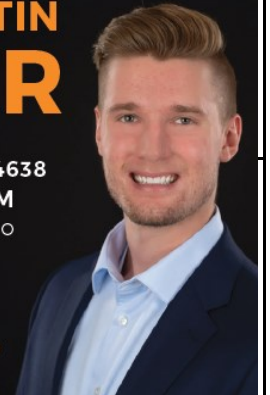
