McChoir's Music Corner

The Ascension of the Lord

After Easter, most musicians hit 'cruise control' after the liturgies of Holy Week and the Easter Octave. Now that we've had a little time to reset—today begins a set of 4 liturgies that contain some special themes and music. We celebrate the Ascension of the Lord today, a solemnity transferred from the scriptural 40 days (which would be last Thursday) where Christ ascends into heaven. Next comes Pentecost, the gift of the Holy Spirit, the tongues of flame that descended upon the Apostles, giving a formal "birthday" to the Christian church. After that comes Trinity Sunday, about which I've heard a few priests jokingly call 'Heresy Sunday' as they try and explain the mystery of the Trinity during their homily without committing some minor heresy by analogy. Finally, we celebrate Corpus Christi Sunday, the high feast of the Body and Blood of the Lord. 4 weeks worth of special celebrations as we transition to Ordinary Time, what a hoot! I created a blog post to explain these celebrations a little bit, and give particular attention to the music that accompanies them. 
