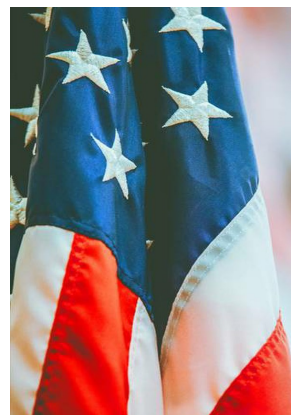

McChoir's *Music* Corner

"Come, O Holy Spirit Come."

Happy Birthday to the Church! Today we celebrate the end of the Easter season with the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, gifting them with tongues of flame to go and spread the Gospel to all corners of the earth. This action helped make the church 'catholic,' or 'universal.' Today's Sequence Hymn "Veni Sancte Spiritus" is the second of four sequences used in the modern Catholic Church during the liturgical year. The typical form of a sequence hymn is followed where the text is presented in 'couplets,' meaning each melody is repeated twice as the text is presented. It's a text worth revisiting and praying with today, as we read from the second reading: "No one can say 'Jesus is Lord,' except by the Holy Spirit." We need the Holy Spirit active in our lives, and we need to call out asking for the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Take a little time with the text of this sequence, and also look up the 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit, and discern in prayer what gifts are strong in you already, and what gifts you can focus on in the coming weeks.

Who are the Fishermen?

The Fishermen is a men’s apostolate at Sts. Anne and Joachim parish. The purpose of the Fishermen is to help men grow in faith, virtue, and to become the servant leaders within their families, Church and community that God created them to be.

Candidates go through an 8-month formation program that includes:

- Discovering the true meaning of Catholic masculinity
- Consecration to Jesus through Mary
- Praying the Liturgy of the Hours
- Hear God speak to you through Sacred Scriptures
- Study of the Sacraments/Catechism of the Catholic Church

Upon completion of the formation period, Fishermen are licensed through the apostolate to share what they have learned with others and meet for faith formation and fellowship. The Fishermen is open to all Catholic men in our parish.

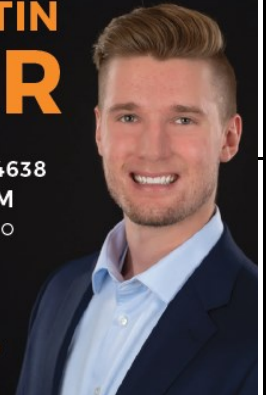
