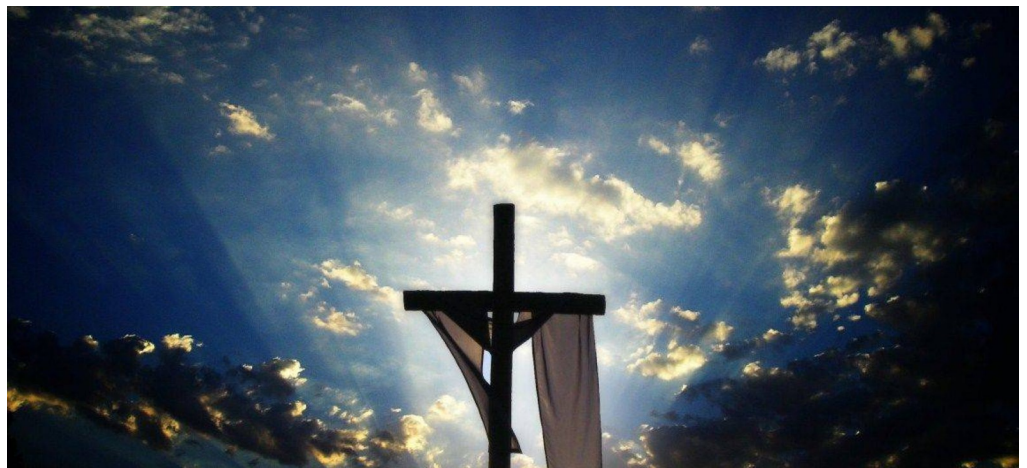

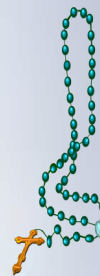

McChoir's *Music* Corner

July 7th – 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Here's something you probably don't think about too often: Melodic similarity of hymn tunes within the same liturgy. That's a fancy way of saying 'two songs that sound similar at Mass.' Our processional hymn (I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say) and recessional hymn (There's a Wideness in God's Mercy) today are similar in a few ways musically: They share the same key signature (though the processional is in minor mode and the recessional is major), and the first three pitches are the same. There are small moments where the notes and rhythms line up almost perfectly, and the general idea of the melody is similar: a descending pattern followed by ascending material before settling back down. The climax tone (the highest note) of both hymns is a D-natural. Why does any of this matter? Well, when we sing tunes that share similarities, there is repetition in some form to aid your ease of access to participate. If we use metrical tunes like these consistently, the context your brain has to process the notes and words on the page is strengthened. This is one of the key considerations for me each and every week as we sing hymns. I hope you engaged the text and the music for these and all the sung parts of the Mass fruitfully during today's celebration!

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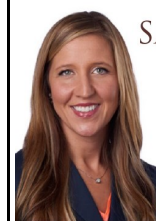
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
