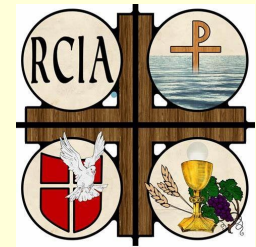

McChoir’s Music Corner

Ausut 28th – 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

I’m willing to bet that Bishop Cozzens and the rest of the planning committee for the Eucharistic Revival were very intentional to gather in Indianapolis and kickstart the Year of Mission right as we begin ready the famous “Bread of Life” discourse in our Sunday Masses. Last week through the end of August our Gospel readings will be taken from John 6—and as such, the emphasis of the Eucharist will be apparent each weekend. This weekend our recessional hymn was “Jesus, My Lord, My God, My All.” The refrain is well known, and rings so true: “Sweet Sacrament, we thee adore! O, make us love thee more and more.” The tune is an old German hymn that likely originated sometime in the late 18th or early 19th-century, and was first published in the *Romischkatholisches Gesangbuchlein*, (“Roman Catholic Hymn Book”) of 1826. The text comes from the great Frederick Faber, who was directly influence by St. John Henry Newman to convert from the Church of England to Catholicism. Together, the words and melody make up a wonderful devotional hymn about Jesus in the Eucharist, and I hope it feeds your soul as you ponder the mystery of the Eucharist over the next month.

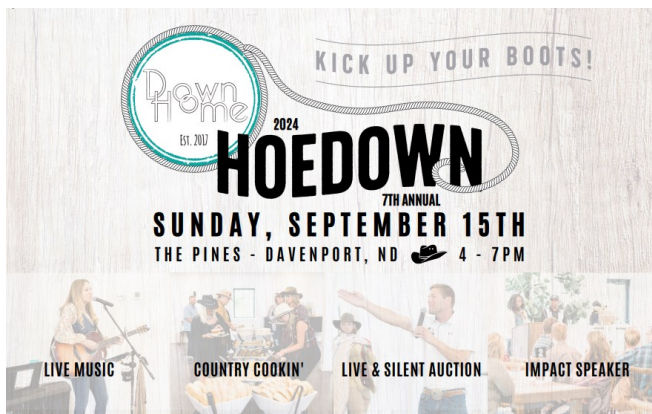
