STEWARDSHIP MOMENT

"Get up and eat or the journey will be too much for you!"
 1 KINGS 19:7

God knows that committing to a stewardship lifestyle is difficult. However, we were not designed to do it on our own, we need God's help. Fortunately, God gave us the greatest gift of all, His son, Jesus. Through the gift of the Eucharist, we unite our sacrifice with Jesus' sacrifice to do the will of God, Our Father. We receive the strength and courage to be His missionary disciples.

Do you have any children in need of the sacraments of Baptism after seven years of age, or Confirmation and First Communion after third grade?

In the academic year of 2023-2024, Sts. Anne and Joachim added a class due to the need of children outside the regular track that were in need of the sacraments of initiation. In 2024, we had 29 children that needed the sacraments and were in middle or high school. There were also six children that received Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation during the Easter Season.

This class is called the "Rite of Christian Initiation for Children" (RCIC). This class is for children who were not baptized as infants or who are baptized but have not received any formal religious education, who have attained the use of reason (seven years of age or older) and are of catechetical age. The class runs congruent with our regular Religious Education classes on Wednesdays from September 11 thru April. 30 The class starts at 6:30—7:40pm in one of the classrooms at the Shanley High School. Within this time, the children receive instruction about the fundamentals of the Catholic Faith, along with specialized instruction as to the sacraments they will receive.

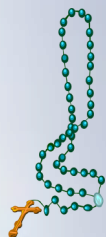

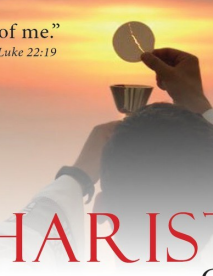

Today's communion antiphon is from Psalm 147, "O Jerusalem, glorify the Lord, who gives you fill of finest wheat." To pair this text with a hymn, we sang "Gift of Finest Wheat" with words by Omer Westendorf and music by Robert E. Kreutz. Westendorf is a person worth remembering for a moment here—he was a highly influential American Catholic musician of the 20th century. He started as a choir master in 1936, and would temporarily leave his position to serve in World War II. During his time in Holland, he learned many new hymns and styles of music he had not yet been exposed to, and brought a large assortment of new music back to the states. With a massive stockpile of music previously unheard in the U.S., Omer founded the World Library of Sacred Music in 1950, and championed the reforms of the Second Vatican Council when they were introduced. His work with the St. Bonaventure Choir received national acclaim as they toured to different churches and offered public concerts, and recorded several albums. His work serves as an example of synthesizing the music of the world into the sacred realm of worship in the liturgy, and his text we sing today remains a testament to his noble efforts.
