**McChoir's Music Corner**

You may have seen Fr. Meyer and I's silly announcement video last week about our new hymnal (*or, properly: missal*) that our parish will begin using in Advent. If you didn't see it, check out the video on our parish YouTube page! We are very excited about the change, even though sometimes change can be a little difficult. To assist with this, I am dedicating each of my "McChoir Corners" over the next month to some practical tips for everyone in the pew as we make the transition.

Here's the first tip: look at the circles that we call 'music notes.' To some, that instruction may seem silly, but in my experience of teaching singers young and old how to read music—especially church music—this is something that takes some getting used to. When your brain processes new information, it uses previously established context to inform the learning process. That is a fancy way of saying 'what you know already will influence the way you learn something new.' So, if you don't usually read music notes, your eyes are likely focused solely on the text when you to sing from the hymnal. It takes a little practice and intentional effort to do something that you're not used to, so make it easy on yourself and practice with something we already know: if you don't usually pick up the "Mass of St Phillip Neri" card when we sing the 'Lord have mercy... Glory to God... Alleluia...' and so on, pick it up and use the information on the page! The action of reading music while singing is like a form of brain cardio, it's a great exercise for the brain to keep you sharp. In addition, it will help orient your mind to process what you see on the page with what you hear from the organ, piano, cantor, and/or choir. Stay tuned for more practical tips to make the transition to the new missal smooth as butter!
