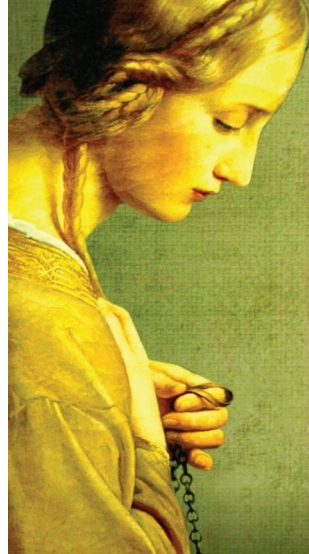

Patrick McGuire's Music Corner

One of the great things about the metrical hymns we use each week is that there are many melodies (the music notes) that fit with multiple hymn texts (the words). This allows us to participate with familiar tunes and focus on the content of the words even more as we "pray twice" in song! Our Communion Hymn today was a great example of this, "Portal of the World's Salvation" set to the tune, "ST. THOMAS (WADE)." You likely recognize this melody best with the "Tantum Ergo" or "Down in Adoration Falling" text. It's very common for Benediction at the end of adoration, or on Holy Thursday!

The text we sing today however, echoes the message of the communion antiphon, and we sing of Mary, our dear mother, who herself was the 'portal' through which God came to the earth. Take a moment and revisit this text at somepoint in the next few days, perhaps even as you come back for Christmas Mass on Tuesday/Wednesday—this is a beautiful Catholic text from the 15th century that has been translated and poetically set in English for us to benefit from.
