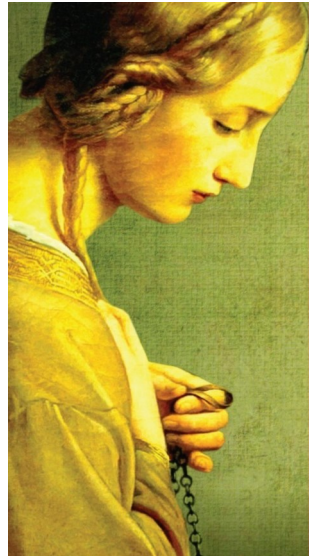

Patrick McGuire's Music Corner

Most people around here know "We Three Kings," a perfect hymn for the day! It was written by an Episcopalian priest named John Henry Hopkins Jr. (not to be confused with Johns Hopkins, founder of Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore, MD). He was a well-known religious figure in the late 19th century in America, so much so that he offered the eulogy at Ulysses S. Grant's funeral. Hopkins' lyrics and tune have become a Christmas staple in so many different communities. As I researched the tune, I discovered that though he originally wrote the carol in 1857, it does not appear to be published in any collection until 1863, in a publication by Hopkins Jr. himself. This makes me wonder: did the people who first sang this 'new

hymn' have any idea that it would become the well-loved tune we know and sing today? In fact, I am willing to bet there were a few characters in his church who were disgruntled by this new hymn about the wise-men when they first sang it. Everything was new at one time, and over time, history has a way of remembering, preserving, and promoting 'the true, the good, and the beautiful.' I'm glad that John H. Hopkins Jr. was brave enough to write down this hymn and offer it to the world, we have all benefitted from it some 150+ years later!
