Patrick McGuire's Music Corner

Today's psalm was a simple statement: "The Lord will bless his people with peace." (*Ps 29:11b*) It's a nice idea, we like the thought of peace! But the peace that Christ will give is a special peace, a "peace the world cannot give." (*Jn 14:27*) The world offers us all kinds of peace, and though not inherently bad, 'worldly peace' can still distract us from the peace of Christ. Music offers a great example of this: secular music from the world can be beautiful, true, powerful, meaningful, and a host of other great things! And yet, secular music has no place in the sacred worship of Holy Mass. If we get too wrapped up in secular music, we might to try and place a secular song into worship at Mass, and this has now distracted us from the core purpose of our sacred music in worship: "the glory of God, and the sanctification of the faithful." (*SC112*) There is nothing wrong with secular music, but it does

not belong to the Mass, it belongs to the world. In fact, the word 'sacred' comes from the Latin 'sacrare' (to make holy/consecrate). If something is made 'holy,' that means it has been 'set apart.' Look around you at Mass, and you will see all kinds of unique vessels, gestures & postures, words, music, and even the church building itself having unique features that we don't see or hear in the secular world. When we come to church we are enveloped by sacred objects, words, music, and actions, to unite us all in our communal worship of the Most Holy Creator of the Universe! By being 'set apart' from the world, we focus on Jesus who offers us the "peace the world cannot give."

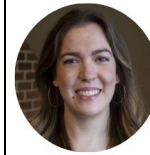
