McChoir's Music Corner

Perhaps you have not realized yet, but congratulations—you've successfully sung Gregorian chant! Over the past few months, the melodies we have been singing during the 'Alleluia' are taken from Gregorian chant melodies. I have really enjoyed hearing the congregation have success with these tunes! §41 of the General Instruction of the Roman Missal states, "All other things being equal, Gregorian chant holds pride of place because it is proper to the Roman Liturgy." It is a sincere treat to sing this music that is a part of our liturgical heritage. Our participation in this type of singing unites us ever more closely to our Catholic faith, which is 'ever ancient, ever new.'

There is evidence to suggest that many of the Gregorian chant melodies maintained in the Catholic Church actually developed from the chanted melodies of Jewish synagogues from the time of Christ himself. I sometimes wonder as I sing these short refrains before the Gospel: what if Jesus Christ sang this same tune? What a thrilling prospect!
