Lenten Regulations: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

McChoir's Music Corner

"Laetare Jerusalem!" Today you hopefully noticed a different 'feel' to the music of today's liturgy. The 4th Sunday of Lent is known as "Laetare Sunday," named after today's Entrance Antiphon, the text of which is from Isaiah: "*Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast.*" (Is 66: 10, 11) The normal regulations about music in the season of Lent are lifted just for today, highlighting the joy to come in the heavenly Jerusalem.

We have hope because of Christ's death and resurrection, which we will celebrate in just a few more weeks. At the beginning of Lent we are told to "Repent, and believe in the Gospel," and, "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return," both statements ought to lead us beyond our life here and now, and get us thinking of things above. Our hope is to live in the heavenly realm (Jerusalem) with Jesus our Savior, and join in the choir of angels who sing His praise.
