McChoir's Music Corner

The choir year is now over, and I can't help but hear the melody of Thomas Tallis' choral setting of today's communion antiphon from John 14: "If you love me, keep my commandments..." Tallis took this passage and wrote a simple anthem, 'If Ye Love Me,' that has been a hallmark choral piece for choirs Catholic and otherwise for hundreds of years. This anthem comes from an interesting time in sacred music history in England. Tallis was one of two British composers of his time who had print permissions from Queen Elizabeth I, the other being Tallis' student, William Byrd. Not only is it interesting that Tallis and Byrd maintained sole-printing rights from the Queen, but both composers were sort of 'double agents' in sacred music: Both were secretly practicing Catholics, but served the Church of England in a formal and public capacity. They wrote English music for the Church of England, and used the same melodies for Latin works to be used in secret in Catholic services that were being held underground during a time of persecution.

Two paydays for one piece of music—church musicians are always looking for a quick 'buck!' As a result, many of the motets and Mass settings written during this time in England are quite a bit shorter than the music written in other places, as the Masses held in secret could not meet for very long, lest they be caught in the criminal act of Catholic worship at odds with the Queen's decrees. Some historians suggest that Queen Elizabeth actually knew that both Tallis and Byrd were secretly maintaining occupation and output to the Catholic congregations in England, and chose not to execute or jail them out of affection for their musical ability that served her own purposes for the Church of England. In any event, today's communion antiphon emphasizes our need to follow the law of the Lord, to stay close to his decrees and follow His Word. Perhaps this was an encouragement for Tallis himself, who sought to serve the whole of Christianity in England and promote the law of the Lord with sacred music before submitting completely to the law of the land.

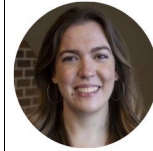
