McChoir's Music Corner

I can't help but smile as soon as I think of today's opening hymn: "Holy, Holy, Holy," (*NICAEA*) because I know my daughter will be singing it with a smile on her face! At just 3 years old, she latched onto this tune after it came up a few times during the summer, and sang it to me before bed one night (with a few adorable substitutes for the actual text). Of course she is the daughter of the church music director, so she's exposed to a lot of music in general, but I think this highlights the benefit of our metrical hymns for our church: These melodies are designed for the masses (no pun intended!), and that even includes our little children in the pews! I bet you with a little coaxing, your toddler can sing some of the Mass

parts where the text doesn't change each week: the 'Lord have Mercy,' the 'Alleluia,' or the great 'Amen.' We lovingly refer to our 9:15am Mass as the 'rainforest Mass,' and if I may, I hear some great singing voices 'out in the jungle!' I invite you to take the Mass Ordinary cards in your pew and point out the notes on the page when we sing the Mass parts to help them follow along and get involved! Even if they are a ways off from reading words, they can begin associating the small circles on the page going 'up' or 'down' with the pitches that everyone sings. Who knows? You might have a future church musician sitting next to you in the pew!

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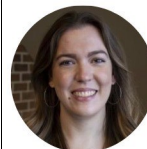
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
