A 'Catholic Classic' for Mass

The communion antiphon today is the subject of one of the most famous Catholic motets of all time: Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina's "Sicut cervus." In church choir circles, this is one of the most-well known and sung motets in the Catholic choral repertoire. The text is from Psalm 42, "Like the deer that yearns for running streams, so my soul is yearning for you, my God." (Ps 42: 2)

Since it is the very first weekend for the choir, we won't be able to sing it today at Mass, but come back for the 4pm concert today, "Catholic Classics," and you will get to hear a performance of this piece among many other great treasures of the Catholic repertoire! We will feature many great choral treasures and chants from the Catholic tradition of sacred music throughout history. It will be a great event to kick off our fall singing season with all the ensembles coming back together as of this week.

This time of year is always such a joy for me as a director of music—just this past Wednesday, over 50 people gathered to sing in our first rehearsals for the choir year, the energy and enthusiasm for music in this parish is such a gift to us all. I'm very grateful for the people who are involved and invest so much time into making our experience of worship so beautiful!

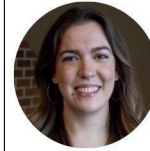
