McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

We Should Glory in the Cross

Today, Ordinary Time is slightly interrupted by this Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. We celebrate this feast every year on September 14th, and since it falls on a Sunday this year, we get the extra opportunity to highlight the glory of the cross of Christ.

I think one of the common questions one might hear from our Protestant brothers and sisters, is why there is such a prominence of the Crucifix (being the cross that features the 'corpus' or body of the Lord) in Catholic Church. Today's text for the entrance antiphon gives us a good answer: "We should glory in the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, in whom is our salvation, life and resurrection, through whom we are saved and delivered." (Cf. Gal 6:14) This same text is used to open the Holy Thursday liturgy to begin the Sacred Paschal Triduum during Holy Week, and the choir will sing a setting of this text during the 9:15 Mass this weekend!

We recognize that it is through Christ's suffering and death on the cross that we have our salvation. Christ was a sacrificial offering for our sins, and this incredible act of his crucifixion is the greatest act of love the world has ever known. So we venerate the cross upon which he hung, and gaze upon his pierced flesh that conquered the cross, turning it from a symbol of torture and death, to a symbol of hope and love.

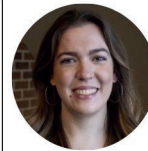
