Administrative Office Specialist

The Administrative Office Specialist provides essential support for the daily operations of the parish office, assisting priests and staff while managing communications, records, and databases. Key responsibilities include handling correspondence, maintaining parish and donor records, supporting sacramental recordkeeping, and coordinating office logistics. Candidates should be detail-oriented, organized, proficient in Microsoft Office, and have prior administrative experience; database experience is preferred.

Director of Marriage & Family

The Director of Marriage and Family leads our parish's relationship ministry, coordinating volunteers and the Relationship Ministry Task Force to support Christ-centered marriages. Key duties include planning outreach events, developing ongoing engagement and formation opportunities, and tracking ministry outcomes. Candidates should bring leadership skills, volunteer coordination experience, and a passion for strengthening marriages in faith.

Property Manager

The Property Manager cares for parish facilities and grounds by overseeing custodial needs, event setup, routine maintenance, and coordination with contractors to ensure a safe, clean, and welcoming environment. The role also works with parish volunteers to support facility needs. Candidates should have experience in maintenance or custodial work, knowledge of building systems, and strong organizational and communication skills.

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

We Should Glory in the Cross

Today's recession is one that I would bet many of you know by heart (at least the first verse!) at this point. "Holy God, We Praise Thy Name" is a beloved Catholic hymn of praise that gets a lot of usage to close a period of adoration, known as Benediction. This hymn was written by a Catholic priest named Ignaz Franz. He was a notable Polish-born hymnologist and compiled many great hymns during the 18th century into a well-known and referenced hymnal called the "Katholisches Gesangbuch," published in 1744.

The tune originally accompanied Franz's German paraphrase of the "Te Deum" hymn, which has been attributed to various saints and notable spiritual figures of the early church—sometime in the 5th century or so! Whoever wrote it may still be in question, but this hymn has become a staple in many communities throughout the world, and is an integral part of the Office of Readings for Sundays, feasts, and solemnities. These kind of hymns really ground us in our Catholic heritage, and provide a common voice we can offer in the context of our own culture and language, as many others do throughout the whole world!

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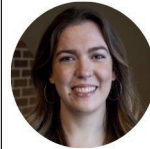
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
