## McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

### *Read What You Sing*

Patrick McGuire, Director of Music

Our world moves so fast! Whether it be our transportation from one place to another, or microwaveable meals, or even buying a book on a Kindle and getting to read it right away—we are so spoiled with how easily things can come to us/we can get to other things. As a result of that in our society, we tend to be impatient in little ways that we may not notice: have you ever stopped to pray with the text you sing at Mass? Be it in a hymn, a psalm, or even the texts we sing every week in the Ordinary, like the Glory to God, or Lamb of God?

I find that taking some time before Mass to familiarize myself with some of the words I am going to sing during worship is a really helpful way to deepen my experience of communal prayer. In a similar vein to reading the scripture from the Liturgy of the Word in advance, the sung portions of the Mass offer some great passages for reflection and prayer as well! As I prayed a little bit with some of the texts this week, the final verse of the communion hymn stood out to me: “And so the yearning strong, with which the soul will long, Shall far outpass the power of human telling; For none can guess its grace, till love create a place Wherein the Holy Spirit makes a dwelling.” If I were to summarize (and over-simplify) that in non-poetic language, it means, ‘our hearts are restless Lord, until they rest in you.’ (St. Augustine of Hippo, from “Confessions”).

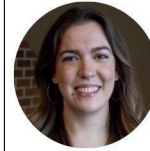
