It's our parish's annual fundraiser featuring food, games, raffles, and silent auctions. **Proceeds will go toward new social hall chairs!**



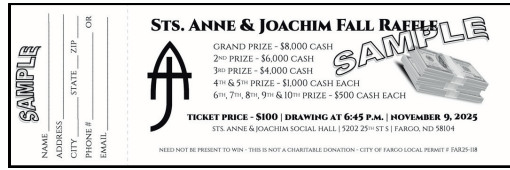

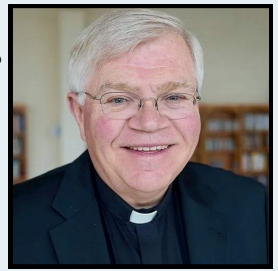

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

Ye Who Follow Shall Not Fall

Patrick McGuire, Director of Music

“All My Hope on God is Founded” will likely be a new text and tune to many of us in the pews this weekend, and I should hope we will sing it more in the coming weeks and months. This hymn is based in part upon a few excerpts of 1 Timothy, including: “For this we toil and struggle, because we have set our hope on the living God, who is the savior of all, especially of those who believe.” (1 Tim 4:10) and, “Tell the rich in the present age not to be proud and not to rely on so uncertain a thing as wealth but rather on God, who richly provides us with all things for our enjoyment.” (1 Tim 6: 17)

Within these words of the Apostle Paul, we see a message that really resonated with Joachim Neander, the composer of the hymn “All My Hope on God is Founded.” Joachim (1650-1680) lived a scandalous life in his youth, but as he began to mature, the importance of God as the focal point of his life’s work and daily living became paramount. This hymn is a perfect representation of his sensibility, in that keeping God at the center of our lives far outweighs any worldly goods we could possibly store up.

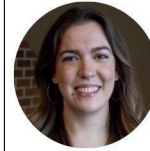
