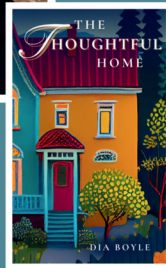

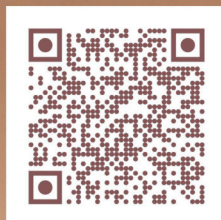

Catechesis in the Domestic Church: The Rosary as a Family Prayer

October is the month of the Holy Rosary, with the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary having been celebrated on Oct. 7th. I would love to share with you the encouragement of Pope St. John Paul II to pray the Rosary as a part of your family's prayer. From his apostolic letter, *Rosarium Virginis Mariae*:

"The family that prays together stays together. The Holy Rosary, by age-old tradition, has shown itself particularly effective as a prayer which brings the family together." (RVM, 41)

"To pray the Rosary for children, and even more, with children, training them from their earliest years to experience this daily "pause for prayer" with the family, is admittedly not the solution to every problem, but it is a spiritual aid which should not be underestimated." (RVM, 42)

"I look to all of you, brothers and sisters of every state of life, to you, Christian families, to you, the sick and elderly, and to you, young people: confidently take up the Rosary once again." (RVM, 43)

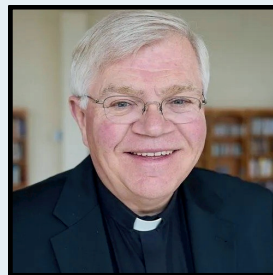

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

We Walk by Faith

The Second Vatican Council encouraged the use of the vernacular language in Catholic liturgies, creating a large demand for music for which there was not a particularly large supply. If you've read this corner for any amount of time, you have likely seen references to texts that were originally written in Latin, German, and even French or Italian as well!

So, with a lot of hymns needing a translation to be sung in the English vernacular, Catholic musicians and liturgists began turning to hymns in the Anglican/Episcopalian tradition. This allowed for quick access to hymnody that didn't require the work of providing translations that not only maintained the original content of the hymn, but could also be set to the rhythm and melody of a tune to sing it coherently. Today's offertory hymn is a great example of this practice, as "We Walk by Faith" was written in 1844 by the Anglican Henry Alford. It has been of benefit to us in some ways, where the strong singing tradition of the Anglican (and other protestant traditions) has boosted singing in Catholic congregations like ours as well!

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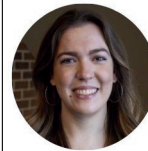
