

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

The Art of Writing Sacred Music

Patrick McGuire, Director of Music

The book of Psalms is known as the “school of prayer” according to our Catechism. There is no emotion or spiritual state which cannot be consoled, supported, or addressed by one of the 150 Psalms of Sacred Scripture. Today at communion time, we got to sing from Psalm 33:18-19, “Behold, the eyes of the Lord are on those who fear him, who hope in his merciful love. (To rescue their souls from death, to keep them alive in famine.)”

The music that carries this text is well-suited to help us pray with it: The opening 3 notes outline what is called the ‘diatonic triad,’ meaning the 3 strongest notes for outlining the tones we sing throughout the refrain. The more important words of each phrase receive more attention musically: words like ‘the,’ ‘are,’ and ‘who,’ do not receive the same musical emphasis as words like ‘behold,’ ‘Lord,’ or ‘merciful love.’ I studied music composition in my master’s degree for 2 years, and this is a difficult skill to master as a composer! Adam Bartlett, the founder of our Source & Summit hymnal & composer of many antiphons like this one in the book, is very good at writing these chant melodies with all voices in mind, allowing each one of us to pray from the heart what we sing with our lips.

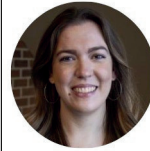
