Catechesis in the Domestic Church: The Bible

Sarah Bofferding, Director of Catechesis

The Bible can be intimidating to introduce to children, as we often are unfamiliar with it ourselves! Here are a few ways to lift up this most Holy book and instill in children a reverence and love for God's words to us:

1. Give the Bible a place of honor – set it on a beautiful cushion or book stand on a shelf or table accessible to children, so they can see it and use it!
2. Read it together – Announce that they are going to hear your voice, but that these are God's words to them. Small verses and stories from the Gospels are a great way to start, like John 8:12 "Jesus said, I am the Light of the world."
3. Show the child how to carefully hold and reverence the Bible with a kiss, like Father or the Deacon does at Mass!

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

Why Do We Sing?

Patrick McGuire, Director of Music

There are multiple reasons one could offer for why we sing at Mass, and one of them is that our song is the natural response of mankind when we encounter our Creator. Take today's responsorial psalm for example: "We will ring out our joy at your saving help and exult in the name of our God." (Ps 20:6) When we consider the goodness of God, our speech is not enough. Cardinal Josef Ratzinger (who later became Pope Benedict XVI) once wrote about the importance of song in scripture, and why we offer song to God, "The importance of music in biblical religion is shown very simply by the fact that the verb "to sing" (with related words such as "song" and so forth) is one of the most commonly used words in the Bible. It occurs 309 times in the Old Testament and 36 in the New. When man comes into contact with God, mere speech is not enough." (The Spirit of the Liturgy, pg. 136)

Whatever we think about the quality of our voices, God gave us a voice capable of singing in a way that no other creature on earth can master. Our voices are united in prayer at Holy Mass, and we join all the angels and saints in their joyous acclamation that is sung without end in the heavenly realm: "Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of hosts. Heaven and earth are full of your glory: Hosanna in the highest!"

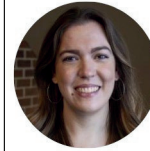
