What is the 'Domestic Church'?

Do you know that your home and family life are **holy ground**? The Church teaches that every Christian family is a "Domestic Church", the first place where faith is lived, taught, and made visible (CCC 1655-1658, *Lumen Gentium*).

Jesus himself lived a hidden life in Nazareth for 30 years, modeling for us that the rhythm of family life helps us grow in wisdom, strength, and virtue. Jesus' early life in Nazareth shows us that growth in holiness takes place in the ordinary circumstances of everyday life: time spent together as a family, shared meals, simple prayers, and patience love.

Your home, like Nazareth, can be a place where Christ grows quietly in the hearts of your family through the small, faithful moments you offer Him.

Take time to reflect this week: *What inspiration can we take from Jesus' hidden life in Nazareth? How can we invite Christ into the ordinary moments of family life?*

The end of the liturgical year is coming! Next week on Christ the King Sunday, we will have a solemn celebration filled with hymns to Christ the King, who reigns in heaven over all the universe. As we approach that celebration, there are many readings and prayers that involve the 'last days,' such as what we read in today's Gospel. Whenever we start to see this proper emphasis in our liturgies, the Church wisely instructs us to be close to the Lord. In the psalm today, we sang "The Lord comes to rule the earth with justice." (Ps 98:9) We affirm that he is a just God, in whom we can safely rely upon to be an equitable, and even merciful, God. We deepen that affirmation at communion when we sing, "To be near God is my happiness, to place my hope in God the Lord." (Ps 73:28)

Not only do we trust that God will be 'fair,' we trust that he is our ultimate happiness, and in him we can find true delight. For God, this has never been about power and glory, he has made us in his own image and likeness, seeking to be reunited with us whom he formed from the clay of the earth. He wants nothing but the best for us, and he is willing to go through the pain of sending his Only-Begotten Son, Jesus Christ, into the world to die on the cross for that union to happen. Now that is a God I want to be close to!

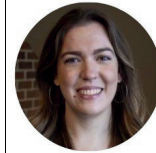
