## Living the Liturgical Seasons & Colors

Just as the natural world has seasons, so does the Church! Next week we begin a new liturgical season, Advent, that prepares us for the coming of Christ at Christmas. One of the most simple, yet beautiful, ways the Church marks the seasons is with color.

**Purple:** before the feast, in preparation (Advent and Lent)

**White:** on the feast, for celebration (Christmas, Easter, Solemnities)

**Green:** after the feast, for growing (Ordinary Time)

**Red:** for the feasts of great Love (Palm Sunday, Pentecost, and feasts of Martyrs)

Children learn through their environment, what they see and hear and do in the home. You can teach about the liturgical colors and season by choosing a way to incorporate the color of the season into your home!

### Christ the King Sunday

Today marks the end of our liturgical year, as we recognize Jesus Christ who is our Lord and King. Our closing hymn today is the refrain of the great "Laudes Regiae" hymn: "Christus vincit! 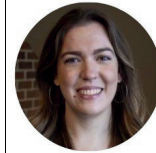
