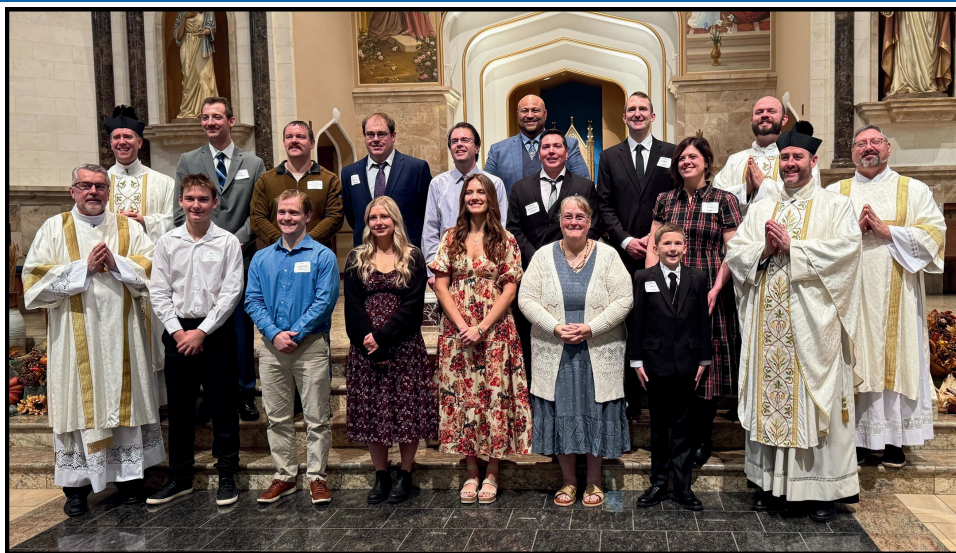

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

The Heritage Mass

Patrick McGuire, Director of Music

As the new liturgical season began today, we sang the "Heritage Mass" by Owen Alstott. We will continue singing this until Lent begins in the new year. I think this is one of those 'comfort classics' of Ordinary settings written in the modern era.

We've sung it here in our parish for the last three years during this timeframe, and many parishes in our diocese (and beyond!) utilize it with some frequency as well. It feels similar to a traditional metrical hymn, even sharing similar melodic content as the hymn, "Holy, Holy, Holy" (NICAEA). When the new translation of the liturgical texts came out in 2010, this Mass Setting, like many, had to undergo revision to be made suitable for the new texts. Amid that transition, the Heritage Mass seemed to be left behind as new compositions were experimented with.

In the last 6-7 years, it has come roaring back in parishes across the United States to become a staple in many churches & schools. I think this is an example of how "good music" starts to stand the test of time: initial excitement wears off as people move on to newer and more exciting things, but in time return to some of what had come before that still delights the mind and heart. That's purely my own personal speculation at this point, but in any case, I'm glad to be singing this setting with you all once again!

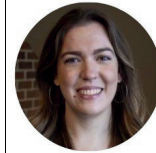
