CATECHESIS IN THE DOMESTIC CHURCH

Feast of the Holy Family

Sarah Bofferding, Director of Catechesis

Blessed Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph!

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that **Christ willed to be born and raised within the heart of a family** (CCC 1655), sanctifying family life by His very presence in Nazareth. In this home of love, prayer, obedience, and faithful daily work, the Son of God grew “in wisdom and in stature, and in favor with God and man” (cf. Lk 2:52; CCC 531–534).

The Holy Family reveals that the family is called to be a true “domestic Church,” where the faith is lived, handed on, and strengthened through prayer, sacrifice, and charity. We see in their example that in ordinary routines and the quiet hiddenness of daily life, God’s grace is at work!

We can ask for the intercession of Joseph and Mary, that our family lives may be Holy, too!

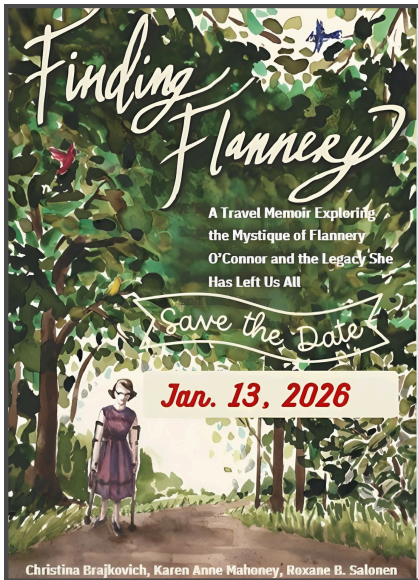

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

Feast of the Holy Family

Patrick McGuire, Director of Music

"Today's opening hymn needs no introduction, I know it is a favorite of so many! Here's a musical fun fact for you about this beloved hymn, "Angels We Have Heard on High." The refrain we sing at the end of each verse employs a musical structure called a 'sequence.' A musical sequence can be defined as a short melodic or harmonic pattern that is repeated at a higher or lower pitch level, creating a series of similar patterns in succession.

See the example below, where each measure begins with a half-note that is one step lower in each subsequent measure, and the eighth-notes that follow always begin one step higher than the first note in the measure before descending. The stable predictability of the sequence, and the accompanying harmonization, is part of what makes this a well-composed hymn for congregational singing and enjoyment!"

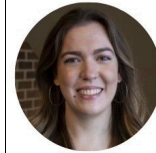

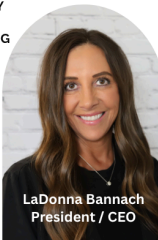
