## McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

### *At the Name of Jesus*

Patrick McGuire, Director of Music

Today's Gospel shares the testimony of John the Baptist, who calls Jesus "the Son of God," and even, "the Lamb of God, who comes to take away the sins of the world." We repeat that testimony in every liturgy, calling out to the Lamb who was slain for our sins. Our testimony, like John's, acknowledges who Jesus is, and in so doing, exalts his name above all others.

Our offertory hymn today acts as a musical testimony of the power and identity of Christ. The author of this text has a fascinating story I have shared in this column before, and it is worth sharing again: Caroline Maria Noel was born in 1817 in Great Britain, and for over 20 years of her adult life, she endured painful sickness. Despite her pain and suffering her poetry and hymnody is grounded in themes of trust and abandonment to God's providential care. She found consolation from her constant physical pain in her devotion to Jesus. We may not have a debilitating illness like Caroline, and yet, the need for Jesus to help us through hardship is still so relatable.

Calling upon the name of Jesus helps us be grounded in our identity as beloved sons and daughters of God the Father, who sent his own Son into the world for us.

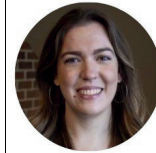

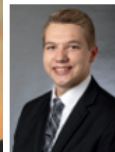
