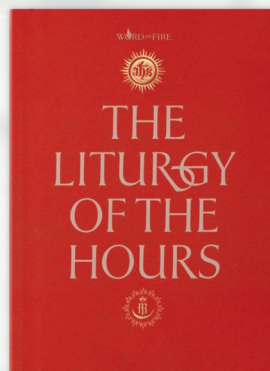

## PASTORAL COUNCIL ELECTIONS



The role of a Pastoral Council member is an important role in the parish family. The Church asks that each parish have a Pastoral Council made up of the lay faithful, over which the pastor presides, who can offer advice and assistance in fostering pastoral activity in the parish. It is a consultative voice for the pastor concerning any issues he brings to them from the parish, or any issues that they may bring to the pastor from the people in the parish.

The time commitment for the Pastoral Council includes five meetings per year, as well as some of the parish activities that take place each year, including the Block Party, Parish Feast Day Picnic and the Fall Festival. The term for a Council member is three years, and there is no second term for any member until at least a year has intervened since the last time on the Council. This ensures that the Council always has “new blood” and is reflective of the parish at the time as it changes grows itself. Three positions need to be filled this year and there is a total of nine members on our Pastoral Council.

# CATECHESIS IN THE DOMESTIC CHURCH

## Entering the Desert

On the First Sunday of Lent, we hear how Jesus is led by the Spirit into the desert. Before He begins His public ministry, He enters a place of silence, fasting, and prayer. Jesus shows us that the desert is not empty, but it is a place of encounter with the Father.

In the Domestic Church, Lent invites us to create small “desert spaces” within our homes. Silence can feel unfamiliar, especially in a busy family life, but even a few quiet minutes can help open our hearts to God. **Children learn silence by experiencing it alongside adults,** here are a few ways to encourage silence in the Domestic Church this lent:

- Try turning off music during car rides (try one a day if this feels too big),
- Pause in silence at your meal prayer, inviting children to share their prayers with Jesus in their hearts for 15-30 seconds
- Light a candle and look at a piece of sacred art, sitting quietly together for one minute.

Silence is not simply the absence of noise; it is space made for *Someone*. In that quiet, children begin to recognize God’s gentle voice.

**Reflect as a family:** Where can we create a small desert in our home this week so that we, like Jesus, may listen more closely to the Father?

## WEEKLY VESPERS (EVENING PRAYER)

I would like to introduce into our daily rhythm of parish life, the common prayer of the *Liturgy of the Hours* by starting to pray Vespers (Evening Prayer).



**It will be at 5:15 pm on all weekday evenings of Lent in the Magnificat Chapel. This common prayer takes about 10-15 minutes and will be led by a priest or deacon.** You may find this 5:15 pm time a convenient time to make a short stop the parish on your way home from work, during errands before supper, or some sacred time after the school day to join in communal prayer that is scriptural, formative, and grounding in the evening.

In order to facilitate this common time of prayer, we will have multiple copies of an orange monthly booklet published by *Word on Fire* that compiles all of the prayers for Evening Prayer (Vespers) into one easy format. For the first couple weeks, the priests and deacons leading Evening Prayer will also offer some orientation and guidance as well. While we will use these orange booklets for Evening Prayer on weekdays, anyone praying in the Magnificat Chapel are welcome to use them to pray Morning Prayer, Evening Prayer, or Night Prayer on their own during their adoration time, or other spontaneous visits to the parish.

I am excited to enrich our parish experience of prayer with *Liturgy of the Hours*. I have prayed the *Liturgy of the Hours* for more than 25 years, and I find the prayers and Psalms so nourishing through all the different experiences of life, interior conversation and encounters with the living God. *The Liturgy of the Hours* is a beautiful way to use the scriptures to nourish the heart and soul.

## McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

### *Love to the Loveless Shown*

During the season of Lent this year, we are singing the hymn, "My Song is Love Unknown" with some good repetition to help us learn a new hymn together. We did it as our offertory hymn today, and we'll use it again in the weeks ahead! This hymn offers a great perspective on the Passion of Christ; and characterizes the deep love of Jesus who gave himself up for us sinners. The first verse really hits home for me: "My song is love unknown, my Savior's love to me; Love to the loveless shown, that they might lovely be. O who am I, that for my sake my Lord should take frail flesh and die?"

I like to think of this in context with the very first thing we sang to begin the Lenten season, The Entrance Chant for Ash Wednesday: "You are merciful to all, O Lord, and despise nothing that you have made." (Wisdom 11: 24-25, 27) God's love is for each and every one of us. Our existence is evidence of his love—he values us so much to bring us into being, and not only to give us life, but to give up his own life for us! I think that is a powerful meditation during the season of Lent, well worth pondering throughout the weeks of our fasting, prayer, and almsgiving that is characteristic of this season.

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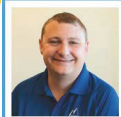
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
