CATECHESIS IN THE DOMESTIC CHURCH

Nunc Coepi - Now I Begin

There is a simple Latin phrase in the spiritual tradition of the Church: *nunc coepi* (pronounced *noonk cheh'-pee*) which means "now I begin." The Church, in her wisdom, invites us to conversion, a daily turning back to the Lord. This is an especially helpful reminder as we enter this second week of Lent.

This Lent, maybe your prayer plan hasn't gone as you hoped, sacrifices have faded already, and your patience is waning. Take up this phrase, *nunc coepi*, now we begin again.

In the Domestic Church, this can help teach your children that holiness is not about never falling, it is about **always returning**. After a missed prayer time, begin again. After a difficult moment, begin again. After sin, return to Confession, and begin again.

Write *nunc coepi* on a small card and place it near your prayer space or on the refrigerator this Lent. Let it become a family refrain!



McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

The Next Right Note

The Transfiguration of Jesus is the focal point of our liturgy today, so we aptly sing “’Tis Good Lord, To be Here” as our offertory hymn. The opening statement paraphrases the words of Peter from today’s Gospel, “Lord, it is good that we are here...” (Mt 17: 4) The rest of the hymn reflects on Christ’s divine nature, and our desire to remain with him.

Musically, this is not the most interesting melody if we’re being honest. Now, there is nothing wrong with it—the hymn works quite well to accomplish the goal of being approachable for all voices and elegantly carry this sacred text. But as I look at it, I am reminded of a famous clip of the great American conductor/composer Leonard Bernstein discussing Beethoven’s 7th Symphony. Bernstein comments that the melody of the 2nd movement really isn’t a melody at all, it’s too simple and uninteresting. And yet, we remember this classical masterwork because, as Bernstein puts it: “it is as if [Beethoven] had a private telephone wire to heaven, which told him what the next note had to be.” Sometimes the melody doesn’t have to be much for a piece of music to be ‘good.’

When everything goes where it needs to and functions as it should, we consider that to be ‘well-ordered’ and subsequently, it is effective. I think that is the case for today’s offertory hymn, and the reason for why I like it so much personally!

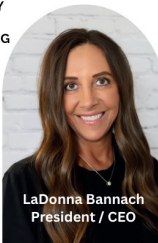

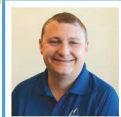
