CATECHESIS IN THE DOMESTIC CHURCH

4th Sunday of Lent: Rejoice!

The Fourth Sunday of Lent begins with the words of the Introit: *Laetare, Jerusalem* — “Rejoice, Jerusalem.” In the middle of the Lenten journey, the Church pauses and reminds us of the joy toward which we are traveling: Easter.

The Introit continues: “Be joyful... you who have been in sorrow.” Even in a season of repentance and sacrifice, the Christian life is filled with hope. The small acts of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving we practice are preparing our hearts for the joy of the Resurrection. This spirit of hope is even visible in the liturgy. On this Sunday, the priest may wear **rose-colored vestments**, a softening of the usual violet of Lent. The color is a gentle sign that the light of Easter is drawing nearer!

In the Domestic Church, this Sunday is a beautiful opportunity to notice the fruits of Lent together. Ask your children: *How have we grown closer to Jesus this Lent?* You might mark the day with a small signs of this joy: putting flowers on the table or enjoying a special dessert with dinner.

Lent reminds us that the road to Easter passes through the Cross, but it always leads to joy, Praise the Lord!

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

Rejoice, Exult, and Quasimodo? Patrick McGuire, Director of Music

Today is known as "Laetare Sunday," because the entrance antiphon begins with the Latin words: "Lætāre, Ierusalem..." which means, "Rejoice, Jerusalem." The antiphon continues, "and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning" (*Cf. Isaiah 66: 10, 11*).

Many liturgies are named for the first word in the entrance chant: Gaudete Sunday in Advent, The Funeral Mass is properly titled the Requiem Mass, or even the Second Sunday of Easter, which many of my colleagues lovingly call "Quasi modo Sunday." This is an informal tradition, but it highlights the point of the music at the entrance procession: "The purpose of this chant is to open the celebration, foster the unity of those who have been gathered, introduce their thoughts to the mystery of the liturgical season or festivity, and accompany the procession of the priest and ministers." (*General Instruction of the Roman Missal, #47*)

By calling a Mass according to the opening line of the entrance chant, we are 'introduced to the mystery of the liturgy for that day.' To that end, I try to be very intentional about selecting hymns that reflect the entrance antiphon texts each week, if not singing the chant itself!

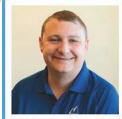
