CATECHESIS IN THE DOMESTIC CHURCH

Holy Week in the Home

This Palm Sunday begins the sacred time of Holy Week! In the Domestic Church, we are invited not just to remember these mysteries, but to enter into them as families! Here are a few things to be lifted up through the week.

Holy Thursday: Recall the Last Supper and the new words Jesus prayed with his disciples, "This is my Body", "This is my Blood", pondering the great love of Jesus, that he would remain with us in the Eucharist! Visit the altar of repose after the Mass of the Lord's Supper or spend a few quiet minutes in prayer at home.

Good Friday: Keep a spirit of silence. Pray the Stations of the Cross, venerate a crucifix with a kiss or touch, and lift up the great love of Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who laid down His life for his sheep!

Holy Saturday: Don't jump into Easter celebration too soon, let this day be one of quiet, expectant hope. Prepare for Easter by cooking, decorating, or setting out clothes, looking forward to the full celebration!

Easter Sunday: Celebrate fully! Light a candle, sing "Alleluia," share a festive meal, and rejoice together: Jesus is risen! Lift up that Jesus' Risen Life is stronger than death, his Risen Light is stronger than the darkness! Ponder how Jesus shares His own Risen Life and Light with us!

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

O Sacred Head

During the final days of Lent heading into Holy Week and Paschaltide, there are some iconic hymns that we may only sing once or twice a year but still remember well. One of those hymns is "O Sacred Head, Surrounded" (PASSION CHORALE). The original text (*Salve caput cruentatum*) is attributed to St. Bernard of Clairvaux. Bernard penned the hymn as a reflection upon the crucifixion by remembering each part of the suffering body of Christ on the cross through each day of Holy Week.

The melody most associated with this hymn was written by Hans Leo Hassler, a 16th century musician of good repute. Hassler's melody was harmonized by the incomparable Johann Sebastian Bach, who used the tune in arguably his most famous and greatest masterpieces, the "St. Matthew Passion." If you have never listened to this masterwork, this week would be a great time to give it a listen! After you settle down for the night, throw on a recording and let the music be an invitation to prayer and meditation on the Passion as we head into Holy Week.

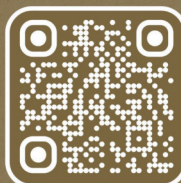
