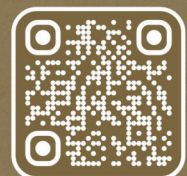

This feast has so much joy, that it cannot be contained in just one day. The Church celebrates the **Easter Octave**, 8 days celebrated with just as much solemnity as Easter Sunday. This is a great invitation for the Domestic Church, to linger in the joy of the Resurrection as well! Here are some ways to keep the celebration of Easter going in the home:

- Sing or listen to joyful hymns, especially those with “Alleluia”!
- Enjoy festive meals throughout the week, having something just a little more special with meals every day (dessert is always a hit!)
- Light a couple extra candles at the prayer table or dinner table, to remind you of the Risen Light of Christ, that is so much stronger than the darkness!
- Recite or sing the *Regina Caeli* before meals, in place of the Angelus prayer

Alleluia! He is Risen!! Eastertide has begun. Today we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. 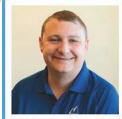

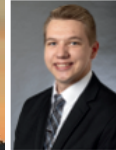
