Remembering Our Baptism

In the early Church, the newly baptized wore white garments for the entire octave of Easter bearing visible witness to the new life they had received. Though most of us were baptized as infants, the Easter season invites every family member to remember the gift of their baptism. When we were baptized, Jesus shared his own risen life, which is stronger than death, with us and made our souls a place where God dwells!

Here are a few ways to lift up the gift of Baptism in the Domestic Church:

- Mark on your family calendar the days of every person's baptism and make a note to celebrate on those days!
- Light a candle at your evening meal during the Easter season: a small echo of the paschal candle, reminding your children that the light of the risen Christ dwells within their own baptized souls.
- Remember all the gifts given in the Rite of Baptism: the water, The Word of God, the light, the white garment, the oils, the sign of the cross.



McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

From Newman to Caswall

Perhaps you are reading this after belting out "Alleluia, Alleluia, Let the Holy Anthem Rise." This is one of many great hymns in the Easter season that we sing with exuberance and joy! There is an interesting connection to St. John Henry Newman and this hymn as well: Edward Caswall is the author of the text for this hymn. He was a 19th-century Anglican priest in his young adulthood, but in 1847 converted to Catholicism, and in 1850 was admitted to the Oratory of St Phillip Neri in Birmingham (Edgbaston). The Oratory was founded by none other than St. John Henry Newman himself, who befriended Caswall and remained close to him until Caswall's death in 1878, at which time Cardinal Newman presided over his funeral & burial.

Caswall's output & circulation of English hymns translated from Latin sources is rivaled only by the great John M. Neale. He serves as a pointed example of the beauty of our church that St. Augustine referenced in his Confessions: "ever ancient, ever new."

By taking ancient Latin texts and bringing them to wider awareness in the vernacular, Caswall fostered the growth of the Catholic Church in the academically-minded university spaces of the UK through his wit and creativity with a pen. To him and many others like him, we owe a debt of gratitude for the beauty that we now participate in ourselves.
