This special month of devotion is often begun with the **May Crowning**, placing a crown on a statue of Our Lady, and flowers at her feet. We do this to honor her, who so perfectly did the will of God, and ask for her intercession - that we may also say "yes" to God, as she did!

May Crownings can also be a way to live this month of Marian devotion in the Domestic Church! Place a statue or image of Our Lady in a place of prominence in your home and crown her as we do in the church. Here are a few ways to live this month in the home:

- Keep flowers by Mary
- Pray the Holy Rosary as a family (start with one decade!)
- Begin or end your family meal with a Marian Hymn
- Plant a "Mary Garden"

Good Shepherd, May I Sing Your Praise

Today is another day in the liturgical year that isn't as prominent as Christmas or Easter Sunday, it is a favorite of many people because the emphasis is on the beautiful image of Christ the Good Shepherd. Naturally, Psalm 23 is the 'text du jour,' especially considering the refrain we sang for the responsorial psalm today: "The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want."

Today's communion chant is a custom text from the Roman Missal itself—this is not a snippet of scripture like it most often is, but was crafted specifically for this day by the Church. "The Good Shepherd has risen, who laid down his life for his sheep and willingly died for his flock, alleluia." And of course, after singing the antiphon, we get one of the most-beloved hymns in our Christian tradition: **'The King of Love My Shepherd Is.'** As a choral musician, I have sung no less than 10 different versions of this hymn in my lifetime, and I hope to sing 30 more by the time it is all said and done!

I always have a hard time keeping a dry eye when I sing the last stanza: "And so through all the length of days, Your goodness fails me never; Good Shepherd, may I sing your praise Within your house forever."

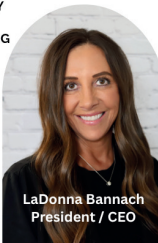

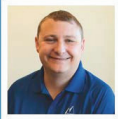

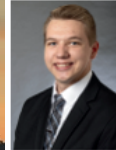
